



## CMBC SEAGULL OUTBOARD RACE

### 2021 Great Tinaroo Raid

#### Background

The Cairns Motor Boat Club (CMBC) was one of the first recreational clubs in the Cairns region and is now a sub-committee of the Wooden Boat Association of Cairns (WBAC).

The Seagull Outboard Race has been running for a number of years and this year will be held on Saturday 17<sup>th</sup> July as part of the 2021 Great Tinaroo Raid.

#### Rules

1. These rules **must be read in conjunction with the GENERAL RACE RULES** provided separately.
2. Seagull refers to an outboard motor manufactured by the Seagull Company in the UK. Only these engines are allowed. *No funny foreign alternatives.*
3. All engines must be fitted with a “kill” switch, able to stop the motor if the driver falls overboard or otherwise not in control of the boat.
4. Only one (1) Seagull can be attached to each boat. No additional propulsion is allowed.
5. The race will run over a buoyed course, length indeterminate and decided on the day. *Generally the course will run clockwise through the start line, around several buoys (taken to starboard) then back through the start line buoys to finish.*
6. The start is with motors running and boats manoeuvring behind the start line. *This gives entrants plenty of time to get the things going and to abuse each other.*
7. The winner(s) will receive the glory of having the fastest Seagull powered boat and will be declared as the winner of the prestigious Seagull Perpetual Trophy for 2021.
